# The Jews are grafted back after being cut off

## Assertions/Conclusions of this article.

To show that the Jews were 'Cut off', that covenant with them was ended and replaced, and that the Jews themselves are 'graft' IN to this New covenant along with the gentiles, the gentiles were not simply 'added' to an existing situation.

This article is to expose this heretical view that says that the Jews were 'always in' with God and we gentiles were just added in with the Jews and shows that this new covenant of our Lord is simply a **parenthetical addition** to the EXISTING covenant (Mosaic) instead of what actually took place.

How these (such as the woman Cindy W and Cheryl -lastblast and cadz.net) do this is by only giving you part of the information instead of the WHOLE picture. As you all know ANY false doctrine can be pushed if we are only looking at some of the data and playing on the words within that small portion of scripture.

What we want to do here, instead of showing you ONLY Romans 11 and perverting a few words there, is show you a more broad spectrum of relevant information so that you see how it all ties in together so when you read Romans 11 it makes much more sense and you can see what is actually being said there.

## **Supporting Evidence**

One thing to remember as you read through the evidence is that we are discussing covenants. We are showing that the Hebrew peoples were given a covenant by God through Moses in the desert, those peoples as a whole fornicated, adulterated, and apostatized themselves from God by breaking the conditions of His covenant time and again for many centuries. Even with threats in Gods word, and even with a writ of divorce given by God Himself to this peoples to show them that He was very serious about their behavior, they still continued in their hardhearted hatefulness towards Him right up till the time of the Messiah.

The Hebrews were removed from Gods care as a nation and the covenant He had made with their forefathers ended utterly, while the few who had been (and would be) faithful were immediately graft into this new covenant along with the gentiles who believe.

This is not a case where the old was simply updated to version 2.0. The old covenant with the Hebrews was entirely removed and they themselves have to come under this new covenant as one of the bride of Christ if they are to be saved.

The Hebrews who did accept their Messiah were immediately 'grafted' into this new covenant upon its ratification at the cross (when it actually began).

Those in the future who end up coming to Him will also be grafted into this new covenant along with the gentiles who believe.

For I speak to you, the nations; since I am the apostle of the nations, I glorify my ministry; if by any means I may provoke those who are my flesh to jealousy, and might save some of them. For if their casting away is the reconciling of the world, what is the reception except life from the dead? For if the firstfruit is holy, the lump is also holy; and if the root is holy, also the branches. And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and became a sharer of the root and the fatness of the olive tree with them, do not boast against the branches. But if you boast, it is not you that bears the root, but the root bears you. You will say then, The branches were broken off so that I might be grafted in. Well, because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Do not be high-minded, but fear. For if God did not spare the natural branches, fear lest He also may not spare you either! Behold then the kindness, and the severity of God; on those having fallen, severity; but on you, kindness, if you continue in the kindness. Otherwise you also will be cut off. And those also, if they do not continue in unbelief, will be grafted in. For God is able to graft them in again. For if you were cut out of the natural wild olive tree, and were grafted contrary to nature into a good olive tree; how much more these being according to nature will be grafted into their own olive-tree? For I do not want you to be ignorant of this mystery, brothers, lest you should be wise within yourselves; that blindness in part has happened to Israel, until the fullness of the nations has comes in.

(Rom 11:13-25 MKJV)

The Old covenant made to 'all the peoples' consisting of every Hebrew of whichever kingdom was 'broken (ended, made void) as shown here in this passage. Gentiles were not simply 'added' to the old situation with God and the Hebrews, the entire setup was put aside and a New covenant was given...

#### Zechariah 11

And I took my staff Kindness, and broke it apart, to <u>break My covenant</u> which I had made with <u>all the peoples</u>. And it was broken in that day; and so the poor of the flock who were watching Me knew that it was the Word of Jehovah. And I said to them, If it is good, give My price; and if not, let it go. So they weighed My price thirty pieces of silver. And Jehovah said to me, Throw it to the potter, the magnificent price at which I was valued by them. And I took the thirty pieces of silver and threw them to the potter in the house of Jehovah. Then I broke My other staff Union apart, that I might break the brotherhood between Judah and Israel. (Zec 11:10-14 MKJV)

It is VERY key to understanding the WHOLE of the data here to understand that God did not simply 'update' the software here but entirely set aside the old covenant to the Hebrews and created an whole NEW covenant at the cross of Christ.

This new covenant isnt just a software 'patch' but an entirely different operating system.

These erroneous teachings alter the facts slightly to try to show that the church is simply a migration of a new system INTO the old so that God did not literally 'put away', but instead 'assimilated' gentiles into an existing relationship with the Hebrew people.

That is not what Jesus shows at all and it cannot be that way or this new covenant is simply a revamping of the old instead of the old being wiped away and the New completely taking its place.

This New covenant was not given to old the old covenant Jew...who puts new wine into old wineskins? This covenant was given for 'one NEW man' consisting of Jew and Gentile who are BOTH graft in to this olive tree.

Therefore remember that you, once Gentiles in the flesh--who are called Uncircumcision by what is called the Circumcision made by hands in the flesh-- that at that time you were apart from Christ, being estranged from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, not having hope and atheists in the world. But now in Christ Jesus, you who once were far away have come to be near by the blood of Christ. For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and who destroyed the dividing wall of separation, having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, that He might create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace, and that He might reconcile them both to God in one body through the cross, putting to death the enmity in Himself. And having come, He preached peace to you who were far away and to those near. Because through Him we both have access by one Spirit to the Father. So then, you are no longer strangers and aliens, but fellow citizens with the saints and members of the household of God, being built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone, in whom the whole building, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a habitation of God in the Spirit.

#### Hebrews 8

Now the sum of the things which we have spoken is this: We have such a High Priest, who has sat down on the right of the throne of the Majesty in Heaven, a Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man. For every high priest is appointed to offer gifts and sacrifices. Therefore it is necessary that this One have something to offer also. For if indeed He were on earth, He would not be a priest, since there are priests who offer gifts according to the Law, who serve the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was warned of God when he was about to make the tabernacle. For, He says "See that you make all things according to the pattern shown to you in the mountain." But now

He has obtained a more excellent ministry, by so much He is also the Mediator of a better covenant, which was built upon better promises. For if that first covenant had been without fault, then no place would have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, He said to them, "Behold, days are coming, says the Lord, and I will make an end on the house of Israel and on the house of Judah; a new covenant shall be, not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day I took hold of their hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt," because they did not continue in My covenant, and I did not regard them, says the Lord. "For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord: I will put My Laws into their mind and write them in their hearts, and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. And they shall not each man teach his neighbor, and each man his brother, saying, Know the Lord, for all shall know Me, from the least to the greatest. For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities I will remember no more." In that He says, A new covenant, He has made the first one old. Now that which decays and becomes old is ready to vanish away.
